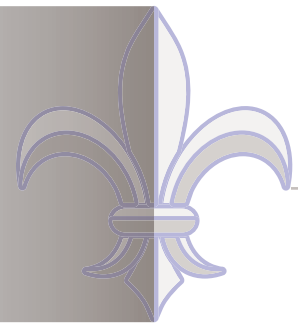

**Improvements Continue, Create Positive Impact**

Summer arrived with high temperatures, hot winds and dry conditions. The new irrigation system has been up and running, and water usage has been more efficient than in years past. You can see the difference in the rough, as we'd be seeing large, brown areas by now. When time allows, Assistant Jason and Irrigation Tech Doug have been working head-by-head to adjust coverage. With more than 1,500 heads to adjust, it's a monumental task.

The contours and undulations of our fairways and rough make fine-tuning coverage a necessity, with some areas too dry, others too wet. Please be patient as we work through the adjustments. Things will continue to improve over this season, with the expectation that more than two years of work will impact play and course appearance positively.

As summer progresses the need for our water storage is apparent. The lake on #7 is our watershed, collecting

and holding water we pump to #17, then up to #15 for distribution as needed over the golf course. Without #17, we have no way of filling #15 other than run-off or purchasing water. Stand pipe and spillway repair will begin on #17 July 5 and shouldn't take much longer than two weeks.

Divot boxes have been removed as there was little use by the members, and the placement was an obstruction for the tee mowers. We have a dedicated crew member that fills divots three days/week and will continue this process through the season.

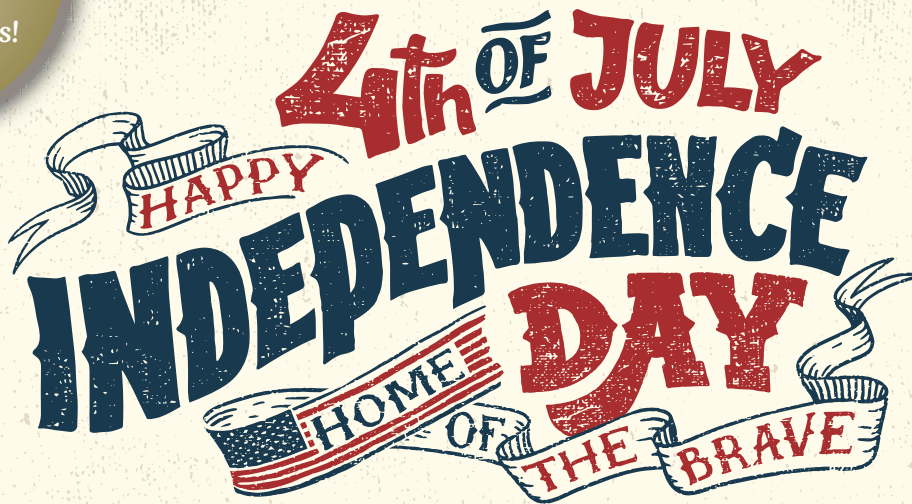

### MONTOUR HEIGHTS ALFREDO SAUCE

#### Ingredients

- 1 oz. Garlic Minced
- 1 oz. Blended Oil
- .5 cup White Wine
- 1 quart Heavy Cream
- 1 quart Chicken Stock
- 1 cup Parmesan Cheese

#### Slury

- .75 cup Corn Starch
- 1 cup Water

#### Directions

In a sauce pot heat blended oil and sauté garlic until translucent. Deglaze with white wine and reduce by half. Add heavy cream and chicken stock. Bring to a simmer and thicken with slury. Add cheese and whisk until smooth.

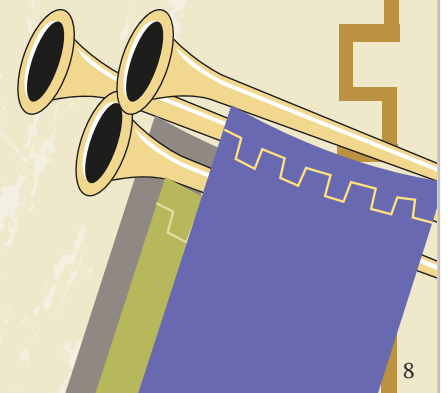
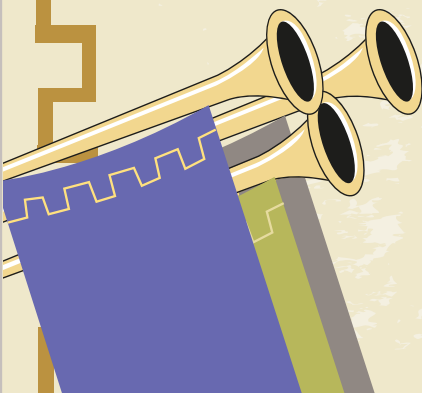
