A SPECTACULAR VIEW

Concrete work continues outside the Heights Grill Room. Since the weather has continued to cooperate (for the most part), it looks like we will hit our goal of completion by April 15. The new patio furniture is in production and should be delivered and in place for our opening golf event, the Spring Member-Guest.

TERRACE TENT ETA

I know many of you are anxious for the tent to go up on the terrace, but we have delayed that a couple of weeks. Originally scheduled for April 1, we needed to hold off a bit. We were fortunate to line up a contractor to take care of the required repairs on the back porch. That work is even more weather sensitive than the concrete! The roof and gutters have been repaired and sealed. The remaining work involves replacing the rotted

soffit and fascia and support pillars. If you were wondering, this is what the green manlift outside the Lounge is being used for.

SPORTS COMPLEX IMPROVEMENTS

The Capital Committee is busy putting together plans for improvements to the Sports Complex. Obvious needs are fencing repairs and renovations to the grounds. Other things such as bar area improvements and upgrades to the kitchen and bath house are being prioritized. GOLF COURSE CONSTRUCTION PAUSE

FROM THE GROUNDS

Spring Course Rejuvenation in the Works

Spring has finally arrived and the golf season is underway. Typically, we'd be talking about spring greens aerification, but the Board of Directors authorized a Spring DryJect instead, resulting in less disruption and faster healing to the putting surface. DryJecting helps mitigate thatch by injecting sand into the green surface, adding firmness.

Normally, grass actively begins growing sometime in April, weather dependent, and core aerification healing can be significantly delayed during periods of cold, wet weather. The small slits heal more quickly than the large core holes. DryJecting is scheduled for Monday, April 24. Additionally, greens will be fertilized, treated with pre-emerge and growth regulators. We're making every effort to minimize play disruption, and try to get and keep greens running smoothly as soon as possible.

Clean up has begun around the golf course. Crew members are currently cleaning up accumulated winter debris, and that will continue until the grass begins growing. There is still some finishing of post-irrigation and bunker renovation that you'll see us working on.

With our eight new H2B workers, there will be a learning curve as we train them, but with the help of our full-time crew, we hope to see them adapt quickly to our regular maintenance practices.

PESTO CREAM

Ingredients

- 3 tablespoons minced garlic 1 cup pesto
- 1 cup white wine

......

- 1 quart heavy cream
- 1 cup water
- - 1 cup grated Parmesan cheese
 - 1 tablespoon chicken base
 - 1 1/4 cups cornstarch

Directions

Sauté garlic until translucent over medium heat. Deglaze with white wine and reduce. Add 2 cups water, chicken base, heavy cream, pesto, Parmesan cheese and reduce by one quarter. Mix remaining 2 cups of water and 1 1/4 cups cornstarch together to make a slurry. Add slurry slowly to simmering liquid till desired thickness.
