Mowing, Mulching, Planting Underway

The grounds crew is in high gear trying to keep up with mowing. The golf course has been in great shape, and we're moving along with our spring task list. Greens were solid-tined and DryJected April 24, and healing is progressing rapidly. We'll be verticutting and topdresssing as the golf schedule allows throughout the season.

Our new workers arrived in early April, and most are picking up the layout of the course and are learning assigned tasks. None of them speak English, but we're fortunate to have a crew member fluent in Spanish who has accepted the position of trainer. In spite of none of the new workers having previous golf course experience, we've been able to maintain the course and grounds thanks to the crew's hard work.

May will be busy with mowing, mulching and summer planting. We're still fine tuning the areas damaged during irrigation installation and bunker renovation, but have made significant progress. We're working on the new cart path on #16, and the old path will be removed as time and labor allow. We started building and planting a new bed around the clock at #1 tee. The plants chosen are pollinator friendly, and more will be added over the summer.

Ingredients


- 10 5 x 6 tomatoes rough chop


