Keeping the Grounds Looking Good


The grounds crew is in high gear right now. Grass demands most of our attention, but we're making time to get to our task list. Flowers are in, the landscape in the Grand Terrace area has been freshened up, and new sod installation has been taking place all over the property. We are continuing with reclamation from the irrigation and bunker projects; work is about finished there. The cart path on #16 has been back filled and seeded. We're just starting to spray weeds in the rough and high grass, so things are really pulling together.

Our temporary workers are learning the ropes and are starting to settle into our routine. The language barrier has been the biggest issue, and I've learned Google translate isn't always 100%. While we're missing our Mexican workers, we've been able to maintain the course and finish some projects with our new friends. The Board has okayed application for an October Visa for our regular workers, and we're hopeful we'll see them in the fall.

The Board of Directors has hired Jason Sloan, golf course architect, to design a plan for tee renovation. Jason was the architect for the bunker project, and it's undeniable that visually the work has made a huge, positive impact.
