

# September Message from Board President Roger Irwin

As most of you know, Ken Brunermer is no longer with Montour Heights. I would like to thank Ken for his many years of hard work and dedication to our club and golf course. No one can argue that our golf course was maintained in very good condition during some very lean times in the past. However, the time has come to move forward and elevate the condition and playability of our course.

### HIRING A NEW COURSE SUPERINTENDANT

To that end, the Board of Directors has initiated the process to hire a new course Superintendent. We intend to have that person in place by November 1 of this year. In the meantime, our assistant superintendent, Jason Lane, has agreed to take over on an interim basis until we hire our permanent replacement. Jason is already implementing some new ideas and doing a great job as Superintendent. Jason will also be a candidate for the permanent position.

### THE LAKE AT #15

Lastly, I want to turn your attention to the lake at #15. You will be wondering why the water level has dropped significantly. We have at least one leak in the liner of the lake. Water is currently flowing from the lake through the dam above our pump house. We have had engineers and geo-techs out to assess the situation. They have suggested that we slowly drain the lake until the leak stops so as not to affect the stability of the dam.

We started that process on Wednesday, August 23. Once we find the leak has stopped, the lake will stay at that level until we have an engineered solution and are able to proceed with liner repair or replacement.

### CRÈME BRÛLÉE

### **Ingredients**

- 3 quarts heavy cream
- 3 vanilla beans
- 1 quart egg yolks
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 3 cups sugar

### **Directions**

Split vanilla bean and scrape. Add vanilla bean scrapings and extract to heavy cream and heat to a simmer. While heating cream, combine sugar and egg yolks in a large mixing bowl and mix well. Once cream is heated, slowly temper it into the egg and sugar mixture. Pour into ramekins and refrigerate.
