- ❖ Member and children through age 24 have unlimited use of the golf course without paying greens fees. Applicable cart fees applies.
- ❖ Member, spouse and children through age 24 are entitled to unlimited privileges to the Clubhouse and Sports Complex, which includes the pool and sports court.
- ❖ Spouses are considered guests relative to the use of the golf course and are subject to all guest fees unless added as golfing spouse for additional fee per month.
- ❖ Active members have voting privileges.

MEMBERSHIP BY INVITATION

INTERMEDIATE

- ❖ Intermediate membership is a temporary membership that expires on the member's 40th birthday. At that time, the member must transfer into an active membership.
- ❖ Member and children through age 24 have unlimited use of the golf course without paying greens fees. Applicable cart fee applies.
- ❖ Member, spouse and children through age 24 are entitled to unlimited privileges to the Clubhouse and Sports Complex, which includes the pool and sports court.
- ❖ Spouses are considered guests relative to the use of the golf course and are subject to all guest fees unless added as golfing spouse for an additional fee per month.
- ❖ Intermediate members are classified by age in the following categories:
 - 22-29 years of age
 - 30-39 years of age

Non-Refundable Initiation Fees

- 22-29 years of age: \$6,000
- 30-39 years of age: \$9,600

(Legacy fee from parent's Active membership: \$525)

Monthly Dues:

Age 22 – 29: \$290; Age 30 – 39: \$350

Golfing Spouse – add \$70/month

Monthly Capital Fee: \$100

Monthly Food & Beverage Minimum:

\$0 – 22 to 29 years of age

\$100 – 30 to 39 years of age

Mandatory Golf Services Fees

\$400 Annually (plus \$210 annually for golfing spouse)

Cart Fee: \$28 pp

JUNIOR

- ❖ Junior members are age 16 – 21.
- ❖ Junior members are not eligible to play in Club golf events.
- ❖ Junior members not possessing a driver's license are not permitted to drive golf carts.
- ❖ Unaccompanied play restrictions for Junior members, when approved by the golf shop, are:
 - 8 am to Noon and after 2 pm on Tuesdays and Fridays
 - After 5 pm on Wednesday
 - After 2 pm on Thursday, Saturday, Sunday, and holidays
- ❖ No Sports Complex privileges accompany this membership.

Non-Refundable Initiation Fee: \$1,200

Monthly Dues: \$190

Monthly Food & Beverage Minimum: N/A

Mandatory Golf Services Fees

\$210 annually

SPORTS

- ❖ Membership is for the member, their spouse and children through age 24 with unlimited use of the following:
 - Junior Olympic swimming pool
 - Multi-purpose sports court
 - Dining privileges at the Clubhouse and Sports Complex
 - Attendance at club-sponsored social events
- ❖ Sports members may elect to play two rounds of golf per calendar month at \$100 each inclusive of cart and fees. Rounds can be used by the member or spouse.
- ❖ No additional rounds may be purchased.
- ❖ Sports members having purchased rounds of golf cannot play in Club events.
- ❖ Sports members *cannot* play as a guest with a full golf member.
- ❖ Sports members having purchased golf rounds may play on weekdays and after 2 pm on weekends and holidays.
- ❖ Two rounds of golf per membership per month.
- ❖ Guest fee is \$100 inclusive. Member may bring up to three guests.
- ❖ This is not a golf membership.

Non-Refundable Initiation Fee: \$3,000

DINING

- ❖ Membership is for the member, their spouse and children through age 24 with unlimited use of the following:
 - Dining privileges at the Clubhouse and Sports Complex
 - Attendance at club-sponsored social events
- ❖ Dining members may elect to play two rounds of golf per calendar month at \$100 each inclusive of cart and fees. Rounds can only be used by the member or spouse.
- ❖ No additional rounds may be purchased.
- ❖ Dining members having purchased rounds of golf *cannot* play in Club events.
- ❖ Dining members *cannot* play as a guest with a full golf member.
- ❖ Dining members having purchased rounds of golf may play on weekdays and after 2 pm on weekends and holidays.
- ❖ Two rounds of golf per membership per month.
- ❖ Guest fee is \$100 inclusive. Member may bring up to three guests.
- ❖ This is not a golf membership.

Non-Refundable Initiation Fee: \$500 (promotions do not apply)

Monthly Dues: \$115

CORPORATE MEMBERSHIP

NON-RESIDENT

- ❖ The Non-Resident membership is available to existing Active members, former members or non-residents who *do not own* property within a 65-mile radius of the Club, or current golfing members with legal residence outside of Pennsylvania and 10 years of membership.
- ❖ The Non-Resident Membership is a full privilege membership providing access to the golf course, Sports Complex and Clubhouse.
- ❖ Rounds of golf may be used by member, spouse or children through age 24.

Non-Refundable Initiation Fee (subject to change)
\$4,800 (applies to new and returning members)

Monthly Dues: \$180

Monthly Capital Fee: \$100

Rounds of golf can be purchased at \$100 per round inclusive of cart and fees

Monthly Food & Beverage Minimum: N/A

Mandatory Golf Services Fees

Single - \$400 Annually (plus \$210 annually for golfing spouse)

Includes: Range, Locker, Bag Storage, and Handicap Fee.

Cart Fee: \$28 pp

NOTE: Not eligible to play in the following Club events: McCune Cup, Dye Cup or Pro-Member

Please review these Corporate Membership Guidelines before you apply for membership.

- ❖ The corporation/llc/llp must be an active, economically viable entity.
- ❖ Each corporate member must be employed/paid by the corporate entity as evidenced by a W-2 or W-9 from the corporate entity, or have an equity ownership interest in the corporate entity as evidenced by appropriate means.
- ❖ The corporate entity must be the main place of employment for each corporate member.
- ❖ All non-sponsored corporate applicants will be interviewed by at least one Board of Directors member.

CORPORATE GOLF

- ❖ Corporate Golf membership entitles two to six designees of one company access to ALL Club amenities consistent with golf privileges as outlined in the Active membership. Member, spouse and children through age 24 are entitled to unlimited privileges to the Club House and Sports Complex
- ❖ One designee must be named the corporate representative and is responsible for approving and communicating with the Club concerning member transfer. Each member within the corporate membership has voting privileges.
- ❖ Corporate Golf membership may be transferred from one member of the corporate to another. A transfer fee of \$250 will be charged for each transfer and must be requested in writing by the designated corporate representative.




