Useful Golf Information

A Message from Your Head Golf Professional

Now that we've had the opportunity to live with the new ClubHouse Online app, here are answers to some frequently asked questions to help you better navigate the system:

How do I remove myself from a tee time I made?

This can be done through the "My Bookings" section of the Tee Time portion of the app. To access it, tap the three dots in the black bar on the Tee Times selection page. (See screenshot at right for reference.)

Does everyone associated with my membership have their own login?

Yes, every person on the account will have an individual login. That ensures that all persons can create their own reservations, and will only receive their notifications.

Why am I not receiving updates to my tee time when people add/drop?

This is something we're working through with Jonas Software. Basically, every time someone books in a tee time, it's a separate reservation, even if it's within the same tee time. This will be an ongoing process to correct, and we'll continue to communicate with Jonas for a solution.

Thank you for your patience as we continue to refine the ClubHouse Online process.



- 2.5 pounds of jalapeño peppers
- 1 cup of water
- 1 cup of sugar
- 1/2 cup of white vinegar
- 1/2 cup honey

Directions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Place jalapeño peppers on a baking sheet, and roast for 40 minutes. After roasted, combine jalapeños and remainder of ingredients in a pot. Place pot over medium heat and reduce by 3/4. Pour mixture into blender. Blend until smooth. Cool and store.

Unfortunately, there wasn't enough participation to allow our Pickleball Project to move forward. We would like to sincerely thank those members who offered a pledge to help fund the project.

On Course for the 2024 Season

March has been a very productive month for us. With the warmer weather, we were able to get spring greens aerification completed earlier than usual. Greens were also top-dressed with sand, and the timely rains helped to wash it in. Greens have also been verticut.

This practice is used to remove thatch and organic material from greens surfaces. Being able to do this earlier in the season is a major head start for the 2024 season.

Our staff has also been able to get greens, tees, approaches, intermediates, and fairways mowed.

We are looking to solid-tine aerify these surfaces except for greens for which we pulled cores. Tees and approaches will be top-dressed behind the aerification.

Everything seems on track to get our labor back starting in the beginning of April, the 15th at the latest. We are looking forward to getting our full staff here and getting out on the course to start the 2024 season.
