New Pond Liner Install Complete, New Equipment on Board

This summer has presented its fair share of challenges with the high temperatures and lack of rainfall impacting our course significantly. Despite these conditions, our staff has performed admirably in managing the situation, particularly with the ongoing relining of the pond. While we do have some brown spots in the rough, this is a common issue in the region under the current weather circumstances.

We are pleased to inform you that the installation of the new pond liner is complete, and as of July 12, our irrigation system is fully operational once again. This development has been a significant relief, to say the least. However, please note that the grounds staff will be addressing drier spots on the course by hand. While we make every effort to avoid disrupting play, there may be times when maintenance activities coincide with your game. We appreciate your understanding as we strive to maintain optimal course conditions throughout the day.

We are also excited to announce the arrival of new equipment at Montour Heights Country Club. We have received new walking greens mowers capable of grooming green surfaces. Grooming, a light verticutting of the green surface, will enable us to provide a finer playing surface, though it is not recommended during the high temperatures of July and August. Additionally, new rollers for the greens have already been implemented, along with two new pull-behind blowers to enhance debris removal efficiency around the course. As with any new equipment, there are minor adjustments to be made, but we are making steady progress toward ensuring the highest quality golf course for your enjoyment.

Update on Otis:

We recently consulted both our local veterinarian and internal medicine specialist at BluePearl regarding Otis's health. Both confirmed that he is on track to live a happy and healthy life, albeit slightly underweight due to his condition, which was diagnosed when he was 12 weeks old. Otis is now 20 weeks olds and continues to gain weight each week. His prognosis is positive. We are delighted to share this encouraging news about everyone's favorite Montour Heights Country Club puployee.
