

The distinct charm of fall golf and seasonal maintenance plans

As the cooler temperatures settle in and the leaves begin to fall, we enter a cooler and colorful season for golf at Montour Heights Country Club. I'd like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude to the grounds maintenance team for their dedication in maintaining the course at the highest standard each day.

I am pleased with the current condition of the course, and fall golf with its distinct charm, will continue to offer a wonderful experience for our members and guests.

As the season progresses, you will notice some changes in our maintenance operations. Leaf clean up will become a primary focus, alongside our regular upkeep. Additionally, we will begin a few important projects, including drainage work, sodding and seeding. These efforts were originally planned for the spring but were delayed due to the pond project.

While the summer weather, particularly the lack of rain, has taken a toll on certain areas of the course, especially in the rough, we've made good progress thanks to the rain in early August. However, certain areas, specifically behind the 18th green will require more attention, and we will soon be aerating and seeding this section.

Regarding the pond project, I'd like to provide a quick update. We've identified a small leak in the intake pipe that connects to the pump house near the 17th hole, and I want to clarify that this issue is unrelated to the pond liner itself. We are actively consulting with several companies to resolve this specific problem. The dry weather in September has made it difficult to proceed with repairs, as our irrigation needs have taken priority. You may have noticed that the water level has not significantly increased, as doing so would exacerbate the leak. Rest assured, we are committed to addressing this issue and moving forward with a solution as quickly as possible.

I'd also like to thank our members and their guests for their ongoing support and compliments regarding the course's condition. Your patience and understanding during this challenging summer have been greatly appreciated. We remain focused on maintaining optimal green speed and consistency as we continue through the playing season.

OTIS UPDATE On a lighter note, I'm happy to report that Otis is in excellent health and steadily gaining weight, which is our primary goal for his condition. He recently turned six months old and is growing like a weed! Emily and I would like to extend a heartfelt thanks to all of you who have inquired about him – it means a great deal to us. Otis is full of energy and loves coming to work each day. We're working with a professional trainer on obedience and commands, including training him to stay away from golf balls (with mixed success so far). But for now, he remains safely leashed to the cart when we're near the greens or when golfers are out on the course.

Thank you once again for your continued support and enthusiasm. We look forward to providing you with an outstanding golf experience throughout the fall season.
